

INFORMATION/RULES

- Entry fees are \$10 per Friday PM and Saturday morning class, and \$20 per class Saturday evening. Stalls are \$50 each.
- Tabs may be run—a blank, signed check made out to Old Dominion Classic Horse Show must be left in the show office.
- If working out of a trailer, there is a \$10 grounds fee per day, per horse.
- Horses may arrive at noon on Thursday, April 21, and must depart by 11 a.m. on Sunday, April 24. If arriving outside of these times, you must call Carolyn Folkers at (434)386-4350 to make special arrangements. An additional fee may apply for early/late arrivals/departures.
- Stalls must be bedded—shavings may be ordered through the Horse Center Office at (540) 464-2966.
- The Old Dominion Classic Horse Show reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes based on the number of entries in the class.
- The Old Dominion Classic Horse Show reserves the right to refuse any or all entries, return any money paid for stalls or entries without explanation or recourse to the show for liability or compensation.

VIRGINIA HORSE CENTER GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

- No smoking in coliseum or barns. This is the law.
- **Vehicles:** DRIVE CAREFULLY. OBEY ALL TRAFFIC SIGNS. No vehicles allowed in the barns. Four-wheelers and ATV's are not allowed on the VHC grounds. Non-powered scooters, bicycles, skateboards, inline skates and heelers (skates in shoes) are not permitted in the Coliseum or the interior of any of the barns.
- **Pets:** All pets must have current inoculations for rabies as prescribed by the state of residency. You must clean up after your pet. **No loose dogs are allowed anywhere on the premises.** All dogs that are not crated must have a leash with a person holding the leash. **Loose dogs will incur a \$100 fine.** **Coliseum: Absolutely NO dogs allowed in the Coliseum unless they are crated. Absolutely NO dogs in the Mezzanine (2nd floor of the Coliseum) under any circumstances. This is the law.**
- No trash or sharps in the manure pits or stalls. Sharps should be placed in red boxes in barns and not in trash cans.
- No lunging in posted rings. Wiley, Speed and B rings NEVER.
- No overnight horses may be stabled in trailers or tied out.
- Horses are absolutely **NOT** allowed to be ponied behind any moving vehicles.
- Any loss, theft, accident or disturbance should be reported to the Virginia Horse Center Security. Lost and Found is located in the Security Office.
- No firearms or fireworks are permitted.
- The Virginia Horse Center shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses, or liability of every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by camper arising or resulting in any respect from camper's occupancy and use of premises, and/or visitor and visitor's use of premises.
